



This report is a synthesis on relations between PEPS and the main actors involved in the ADORE IT activities from September 2008 and January 2009.

The relations, in this first part of the project, have been carried out through one to one meetings and frequent telephone conversations with the main actors identified to be part of the bio fuels chain. This choice, at this step, have been necessary in order to have their preliminary agreement on their involvement in the project, how and how much.

The strategy of this first part of relations have been focused to have a picture of the regional situation objectives in the sector, and general availability to participate, at respective level, to the ADORE IT activities. This task have been successful, in the sense actors, each one, declared to be interested and pleased to be involved in the project.

The most important relations have been established with the Sardinia regional government, Assessorato all'Ambiente, which is the main subject interested on respect European and national target established by law, which foresee the amount of 3,5% of bio fuels in transport in the very short time of this year, 2009. Sardinia region is interested to participate actively to the bio fuel chain promotion and sector development, even if actually it is not fixed the single regions contribute in Italy.

Another important subject involved in the project, which have a diffused presence in the whole agricultural sector at regional level, have been the Agenzia Regionale Laore which is in charge, on behalf of the regional government, to support the development and improvement of the agricultural sector, as advisor and on technical and scientific level. The Agenzia Regionale Laore is interested to participate and to contribute to identify positive solutions, lands, farms and agricultural entrepreneurs for the first bio fuels chain in Sardinia.

A third and strategic regional actor involved is Sardegna Ricerche, the Technology Park, which is the operative arm of Sardinia Region in the applied researches and, at the very moment, interested to identify solution for bio fuels production and use. Currently Sardegna Ricerche is engaged in studying the use of seaweeds to bio fuels for transport production, and ADORE IT project could be a vehicle inside whom create useful synergies for the task.
